

## The Organization:

Our name is Mid-America Hunting Association. We started in 1965 and continue today as a private land self guided hunter organization. For one annual fee we offer each Association hunter the opportunity to hunt any of our land for waterfowl, upland birds, deer and turkey. Our land is in Kansas, Iowa and Missouri.

## Waterfowl Hunts:

We manage six different wetlands, watershed lakes, irrigation lakes and farm ponds. Hunts are both wet, dry and combination wet and field sets. We have over 800 acres of floodable land covering marsh, slough, crop, brown timber, open water and thousands more in crop stubble. We maintain 30 blinds and have wade-in and layout areas. All waterfowl hunts for duck and goose are unguided. The hunter must provide his own equipment inclusive of decoys, calling skills and dog if desired.

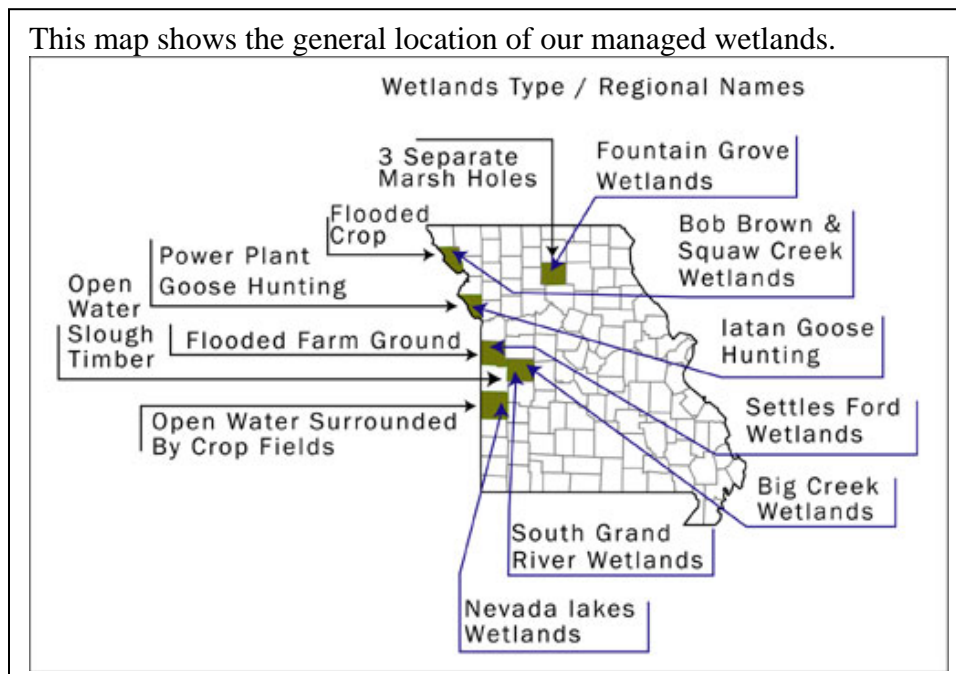
The Association provides the wetlands made available to the hunter through a telephone reservation, a local lodging listing and recommendations of where to hunt.

Hunt quality is based on the right habitat within the right region of each state that has a reproductive history for what we are after. We then limit overall membership as well as subordinate caps based on the hunter's primary and secondary hunting interest compared to our current membership profile as well as our land profile. The objective is never to have too many of any one type of hunter. This allows each hunter to hunt on his schedule any time during any season across our three state region and do so without stepping over the boot prints of others or competing with the public lands hunter mentality.

The two Mid-America Hunting Association partners Jon Nee and John Wenzel are personally responsible for hunt quality and seek to give all the best experience possible. They both spend time on the land year round, they both hunt, and they both know what the hunter needs in terms of the all to hard to get land resource.
